For those reluctant to file an SBA disaster loan application, SBA's Customer Service Representatives are available at every Recovery Center to help with the process, and answer questions. Businesses can receive free assistance with reconstructing financial records, preparing financial statements and submitting the loan application from any of SBA's partners: Small Business Development Centers, SCORE, Women's Business Centers, and Veterans Business Outreach Centers. 
